Dear Parent / Carer

At Bowland we place a great deal of value on educational visits and have a long tradition of organising a wide variety of trips. These range from a few hours away from the school site to multi-day visits abroad. The direct educational and social enrichment which these afford cannot be underestimated.

We believe it is important that parents have adequate notice of forthcoming residential visits in order to be able to plan financially and to be able to select the most suitable visit for their child whilst having all the information to hand. All of our visits for this year have been drawn together into enrichment week in order to minimise any disruption caused by staff and pupils being out of school.

Below is an overview of **residential visits** that will be offered in the **2024/25 academic year**.

Please note that if any of the above visits do not reach minimum numbers of 20 they will not run.
